All information available substantiating PASS bargaining unit staffing numbers for the State of Alaska from 29 June, 2001 to present. At a minimum the information should include PASS bargaining unit staffing numbers, and organizational distribution in the state of Alaska on: 29 June, 2001; 30 April, 2002; 1 October, 2002; 1 October, 2003; 1 January, 2004, 1 January, 2005; 1 January, 2006; 1 January, 2007; and 1 January, 2008.

PARTICULARIZED NEED:

This information is required for PASS to meet the representational requirements of 5 U.S.C. Chapter 71. Specifically, to assist in the representation of bargaining unit members in the state of Alaska in ensuring the direction of the FIRA to the agency concerning case SF-CA-00805 has been complied with, as well as resulting MOA Memorandum of Agreement Between the Federal

Aviation Administration and the Professional Airways Systems Specialists and the National Air Traffic Controllers Association, effective 8 March 2001, concerning the Alaska Region Airways Facilities Division, Post-CMP Labor Management Team briefing and recommendations, dated February 28, 2001.

PRIVACY ACT:

PASS believes that the information requested should be obtainable from a system of records that does not contain data protected by the Privacy Act. However, if that is not possible PASS requests that the information be sanitized so that it is releasable under the Privacy Act.

OTHER MATTERS:

Please contact me if the agency requires further clarification of our request or wants to meet to discuss the request, or a format or means of furnishing this information to the union, or the issues giving rise to this request. PASS requests this information as soon as possible, but no later than fifteen days after the receipt of this request. PASS believes the agency may be in violation of the aforementioned FLRA direction and MOA, requiring immediate remedial action.
